* Thursday, March 4th - Grand Prix weigh-in

ALL cars must be turned in by this date in order to race (include name & number on bottom). Weight will be adjusted at this time only if car is too heavy

* Thursday, March 18th – Grand Prix Race during game time

There will be separate races for Cubbies, Sparks, T&T, Parents & Leaders. There will be awards for speed, clubbers design & overall design. Family & Friends are invited to attend the Grand Prix.
